

Why did BFGoodrich develop the All-Terrain T/A KO3 tire?

Building on the outstanding performance of the BFGoodrich All-Terrain T/A KO2 tire, BFGoodrich developed the KO3 tire to satisfy the evolving needs of off-road consumers by incorporating the latest tire technologies into a tire that delivers even stronger performance and benefits than the KO2 tire.

What are the benefits of the new BFGoodrich All-Terrain KO3 tire compared to the KO2 tire?

The BFGoodrich All-Terrain T/A KO3 tire has improved wear, improved gravel road durability, and improved snow traction while maintaining the sidewall toughness and soft soil traction of the KO2 tire. Legendary Toughness Made Tougher.

Treadwear: Engineered to Endure.

Formulated to deliver longevity on road and in grueling off road conditions.

Toughness: Built to Overcome.

Extended shoulder rubber down the sidewall designed to protect more of the critical sidewall failure zone.

Traction: Designed to Do It All.

When does this product launch in 2024? When will KO3 tires be available to buy?

The BFGoodrich All-Terrain T/A KO3 tire will introduce a total of 111 sizes, over 24 months, beginning in May 2024. In 2024, 35 sizes will launch in three phases: May: 13 sizes, August: 17 sizes and October: 5 sizes. (See information below for details on specific sizes and timing.)

Will there be any F-load rated KO3 tire sizes available to buy in 2024?

When is the KO3 tire going to be available in more sizes?

New KO3 tire sizes will continue to be introduced with 52 additional sizes available in 2025 and the final 19 sizes in 2026.

What products will be phased out?

Comparable All-Terrain KO2 tire sizes will be phased-out as the All-Terrain KO3 tire sizes become available.

My size isn't available now in KO3 tires. Should I wait for the KO3 tire?

No. KO3 tires will only be available starting in Spring 2024 in select sizes. If your vehicle doesn't accept one of these sizes, then we recommend that you purchase KO2 tires.

Why aren't all KO3 tire sizes available to buy at the same time?

The introduction of the KO3 tire will bring a huge volume of new tires into the marketplace, so BFGoodrich is taking the appropriate time needed to make sure we launch the KO3 tire with excellence. A phased approach ensures BFGoodrich can deliver the highest quality product with the highest service levels.

Where are KO3 tires available to buy?

The tires will be available after their launch date through select tire dealers. Please visit BFGoodrich.com to find a tire dealer in your area.

Where are KO3 tires produced?

Most BFGoodrich All-Terrain T/A KO3 tires sold in North America are manufactured in Fort Wayne, IN and Tuscaloosa, AL. A few skus will be made at our Michelin / BFGoodrich plant in Thailand and our Michelin / BFGoodrich plant in Brazil.

Given supply challenges over the past year, how does BFGoodrich expect to deliver a reasonable fill rate on this new product produced in the same plants?

We have activated all available capacity to address current demand in addition to prioritizing LT and high rim diameter lines in the North American market. All of these initiatives are working to ensure product availability of our BFGoodrich offers including the BFGoodrich All-Terrain T/A KO3 tire.

What are the key differences between the All-Terrain KO3, BFGoodrich Mud-Terrain KM3 and the BFGoodrich HD-Terrain KT tires?

While all three tires are appropriate for off-road use, the HDT KT tire is purpose built for heavy duty trucks and commercial use, the KM3 tire is designed for extreme recreational use while the KO3 tire is the most versatile in the Terrain Family portfolio and includes a 50k mileage warranty. The KO3 tire also has the 3PMSF severe snow rating. Consumers and fleets that prioritize 3PMSF and winter traction over extreme chip and tear performance should choose the KO3 tire.





Is there a standard manufacturer's limited warranty on the All-Terrain T/A KO3 tire?

Yes. All BFGoodrich tires have a Standard Manufacturer's Limited Warranty which covers defects in workmanship and materials for the life of the original usable tread, or for 6 years from date of purchase, whichever occurs first. See warranty for details.

Will there be a product warranty on KO3 tires?

Yes. The standard warranty applies to all replacement tires purchased plus a mileage warranty. Mileage warranty = 50,000 miles or 80,000 km. For more warranty information please call BFGoodrich at 1-877-788-8899 or visit www.bfgoodrichtires.com.

How does the BFGoodrich 60-day consumer satisfaction guarantee work?

We're confident you'll love your new BFGoodrich All-Terrain T/A KO3 replacement tires. So confident, in fact, that we back your purchase, with a 60-Day Satisfaction Guarantee. If you're not 100% satisfied with your new tires, just bring the tires and original sales receipt back to the place of tire purchase within 60 days, and we will gladly exchange them for a new set of BFGoodrich tires of equal or lesser value.

Is this product 3PMSF rated for snow?

Yes, the KO3 tire is 3PMSF/Severe Snow Rated.

Will the same size KO2 tire be mixable with the KO3 tire?

We do not recommend mixing KO2 tires and KO3 tires on the same vehicle.

Will the KO3 tire line have a rim protector?

No. We have learned over the years from testing our tires off-road that small rocks will wedge between the rim protector and the wheel, which damages both the wheel and the tire. We do not utilize a rim protector for this reason.

It looks like there is less void in the center tread area of the KO3 tire compared to the KO2 tire. Does the KO3 tire have less soft soil traction because of this?

While the KO3 tire has less void in the center tread area compared to the KO2 tire, the soft soil traction of the KO3 tire is equal to that of the KO2 tire. The upgraded serrated shoulder of the KO3 tire was designed to combat any potential compromises associated with less tread void.

Because there is less void, does that mean the KO3 tire is quieter than the KO2 tire?

For the KO2 tire and the KO3 tire we used our proprietary noise software to arrange the tread pattern in a way that minimizes the noise signature for both tires.

What are the KO3 tire sizes that were introduced on GM and Ford Vehicles in 2023?

The KO3 tire was introduced on the GM 2500 (LT275/65R20 LRE) and Ford Raptor Ranger (LT285/70R17 LRC) as OE fitments in 2023.

Are the KO3 tires that come OE on GM & Ford now available to buy?

GM OE KO3 tires were available to buy March 2023. Ford OE KO3 tires were available to buy June 2023.

What are the differences between the KO3 tire and the OE KO3 tire?

The KO3 tire is primarily designed for the replacement market with a few SKUs that are tuned for original equipment specifications. The original equipment versions of the KO3 tire follow the same trend of being tuned for the original equipment specifications while maintaining the toughness, traction, and tread life DNA of the KO3 tire line.

Will the KO3 tire be an OE fitment on any other vehicles?

Due to contractual requirements, we are under legal obligation not to discuss anything related to vehicle partnerships.

What is BFGoodrich doing to create awareness and consumer demand for the KO3 tire?

We have a comprehensive communications campaign geared towards driving awareness and purchase consideration for All-Terrain T/A KO3 tires, including paid media, in-market events and retail promotional features.
